Fare conditions

- **Ship Saver fares** - limited availability available for specially discounted, non-refundable Ship Saver fares. Amendment fee applies (see [general conditions](#) for more information).
- **Day Tickets** - only available on day sailings and do not include a seat allocation. Cabins are available at night sailing costs.
- **Pensioner** - applies to holders of Australian Pensioner Concession Card. Availability limited.
- **Seniors** - applies to passengers 60 years and over.
- **Child/Student** - applies to primary and secondary school students only up to - and including - 18 years of age. Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- **Infants** under the age of three travel free of charge, providing they are not occupying a bed. Cots are provided on request. Passengers are required to supply their own linen. Infants are not permitted in Ocean View Recliners or share cabins.
- **Passengers with impaired mobility** - A limited number of cabins with wheelchair access are available (see [accommodation](#) for more information).
- **Sole Cabin Use** - Sole use is available on payment of a exclusive occupancy surcharge. This surcharge is 50% of the Flexi Fare adult rate for the applicable cabin being booked.
- **Share Cabins** - Cabins are sold on a share basis and must be booked through the Reservations team on 1800 634 906.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Once you have checked-in, you cannot disembark the ship until arrival at your end destination.

Ocean View Recliners

Ocean View Recliners are a great option for the budget conscious offering low cost, yet comfortable, reclining chairs.

Located in a private lounge accessible only by swipe card, Ocean View Recliners feature individual reading lights and large floor-to-ceiling windows.

The lounge is equipped with luggage racks. Blankets and pillows are also available.

Cots

Cots can be provided for children under three years old.

Cots are only available in non-shared cabin accommodation and are subject to availability. Cots are limited to one per cabin (subject to availability).

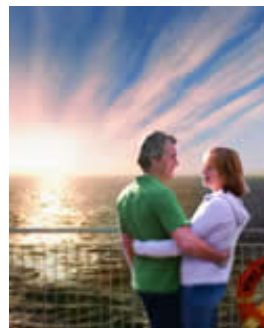
Passengers are required to supply their own linen for cots.

Day Tickets

During the summer peak season and other high demand periods you have the option of travelling on a day sailing with a Day Ticket.

Day Tickets have no specific seat allocation giving you the freedom to move around the ship at your leisure during the sailing.

A generous amount of comfortable public seating is available. Cabins are available on day sailings at night sailing costs.



Cruise Seats ('Seat area')

Cruise Seats are available occasionally on high demand sailings.

Cruise Seats are located in a private lounge and are an excellent low cost option on heavily booked sailings.



Cabins for Passengers with Mobility Impairment

Cabins provide wheelchair access with wide doorways, a shower with handheld hose, safety rails, a fold down seat in the ensuite and a flat floor. Wheelchair accessible cabins feature large porthole windows, a television and also include an alarm button connected to the medical attendant's station.

Wheelchair accessible cabins are three berth. However, a fold up bed is available to accommodate four people. Deluxe Cabins are not wheelchair accessible.

Wheelchair accessible Ocean View Recliners are available, which include aisle seats and seats that can be removed. This allows the wheelchair to be locked into place.

Wheelchair accessible public toilets are located on Deck 7. Power points are available in all cabins and specific Ocean View Recliners.

Commode and shower chairs are available on request. There is also a limited amount of wheelchairs available for boarding and disembarking the ship.
