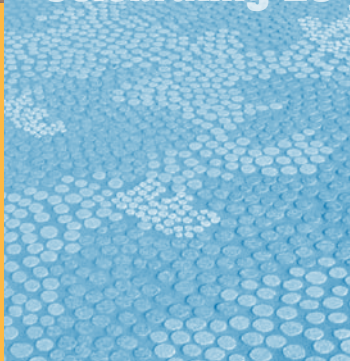

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

The Committee of the 20th ISANA International Conference invites you to submit an abstract for consideration as a:

- Refereed paper
- Non-refereed paper
- Interactive workshop
- Poster presentation

Abstracts should be a maximum of 300 words.

Abstracts should reflect on a topic of high current interest in international education.

This could include presentations in the areas of:

- Cultural diversity
- Intercultural interaction and connecting students into the community
- Enhancing interaction within campuses and classrooms
- Addressing under-representation in student mobility
- Internships and work experience for international students
- Service learning in Australasia
- Building our understanding of multicultural environments and contexts

In particular, the Committee would like to see presentations that are not just an examination or profiling an interest or issue, but offer recommendations and/or an evaluation of work that has attempted to promote and develop integration and interaction. Exploration of best practice in International Education in addition to thoughts on where the industry is moving is also encouraged.

The Committee is interested to see presentations that enhance the educative and living experiences of international students and domestic students engaged in student mobility. In addition some exploration of the work experiences of those involved in international education as educators, support and advisory staff and those who service the international education industry is encouraged.

Submission Procedure

1. Prepare your abstract in a Microsoft Word document using Times New Roman font, 11 point. There is a template on the website.

Your abstract must include

- Presentation title
 - Name, organisation, suburb, state and email address (optional) for each author
 - A short biography (50-80 words) for the presenter
 - A description of the presentation (300 words)
2. Register your presentation via the Speakers Zone title. You can enter multiple presentations.
 3. Upload your abstract. At the end of the registration process you will be asked to upload your MS Word document.
