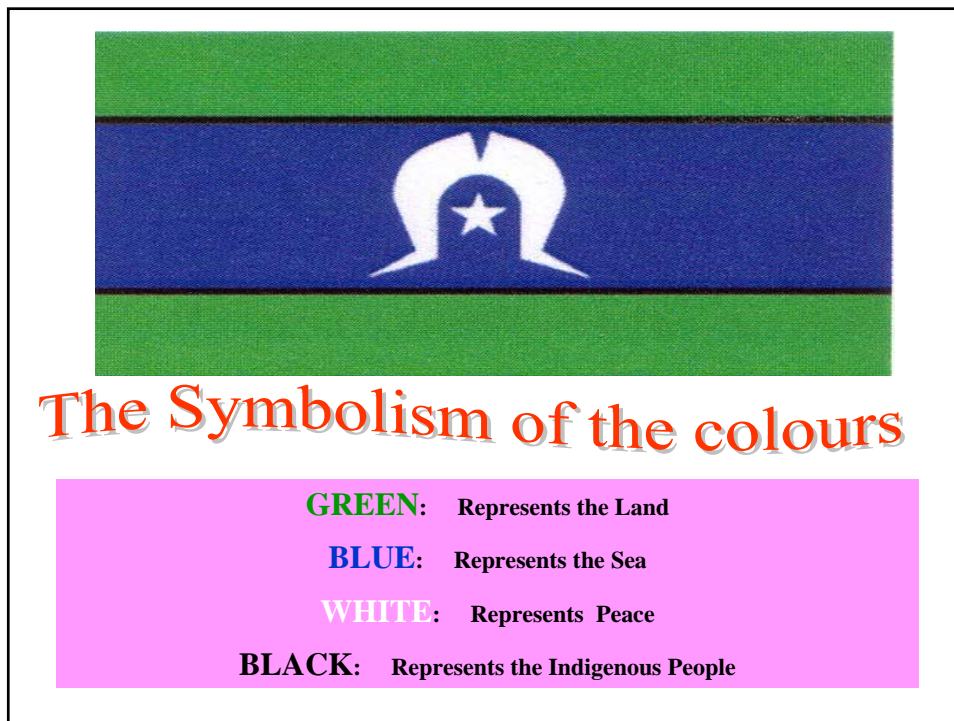


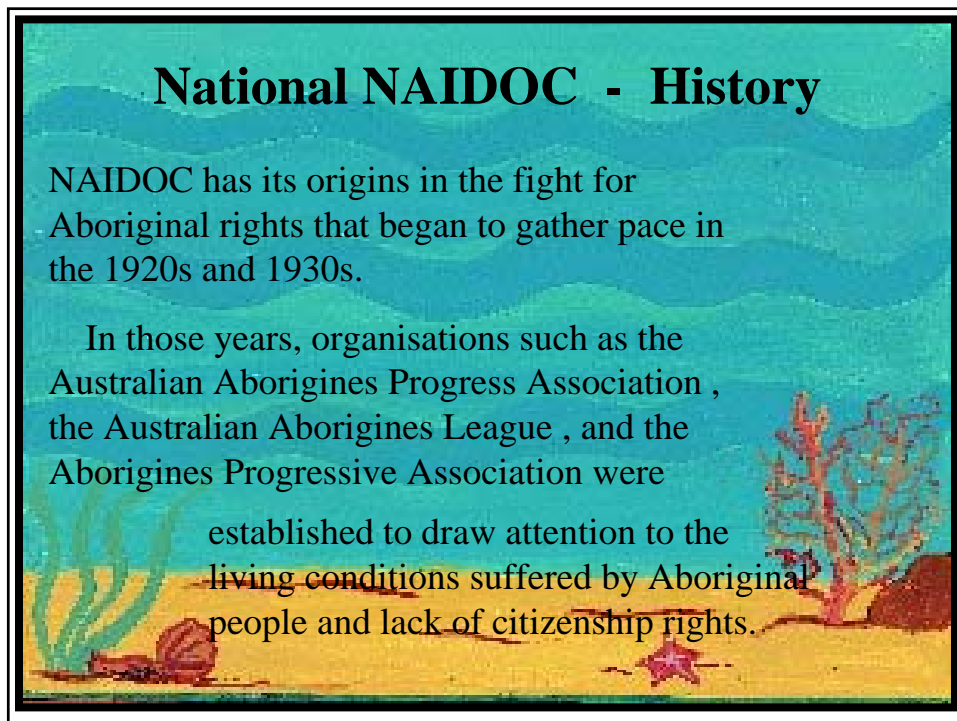
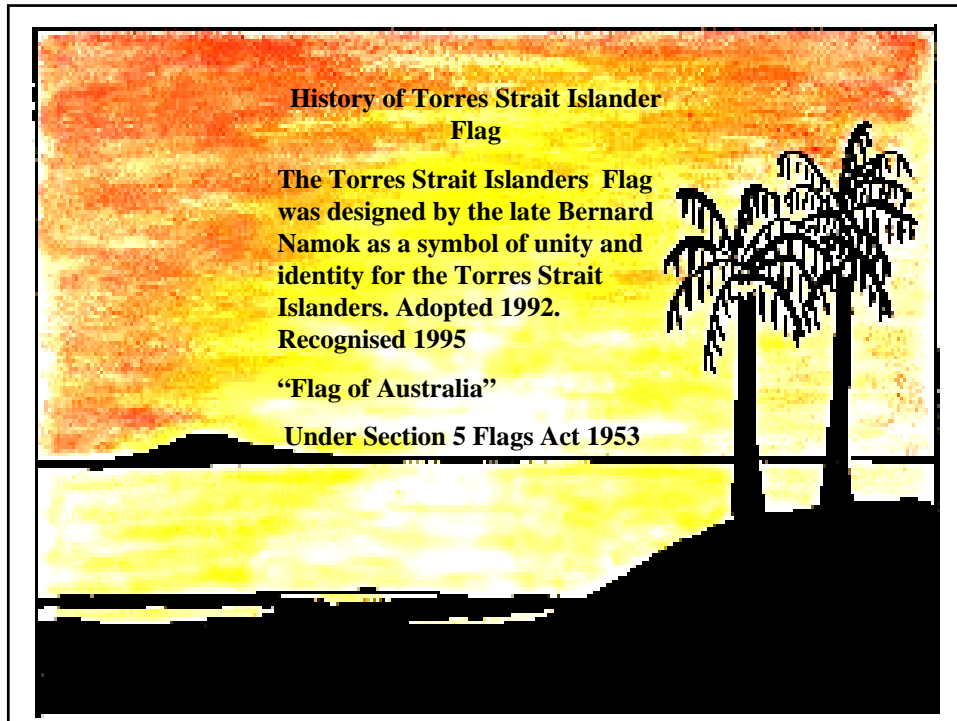
The Symbolism of the colours

BLACK: Represents the Aboriginal people of Australia

RED: Represents the red earth, the red ochre used in ceremonies and Aboriginal people's spiritual relationship with the land

YELLOW: Represents the sun, the giver of life and protector



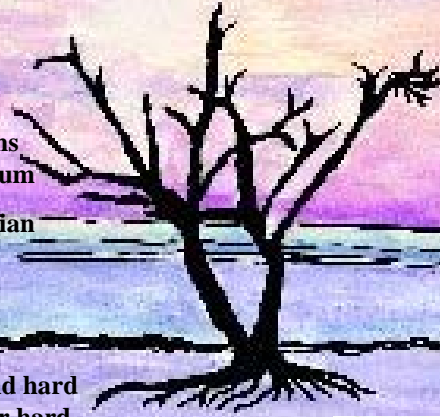


40th Anniversary 1967 Referendum

40th anniversary of one of the most defining events of Aboriginal Australian history – the 1967 Referendum . On Sunday, May 27, 1967, over 90 per cent of Australians voted YES in the national referendum

to remove clauses from the Australian Constitution which discriminated against Indigenous Australians.

Aboriginal activists fought long and hard for recognition and changes. Their hard work proves that change is possible, by standing together, black and white. Australians can work towards equality in health, education and employment.

Vision:

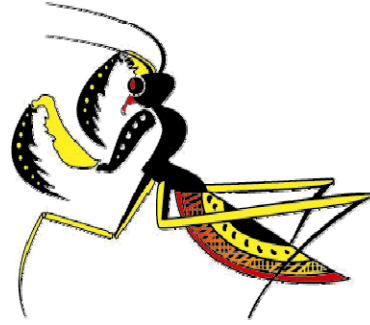
An Australia that provides equal life chances for all, recognising and respecting the special place, culture and contribution of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as the First Australians.

To promote and build better relationships between Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians for the benefit of all Australians.

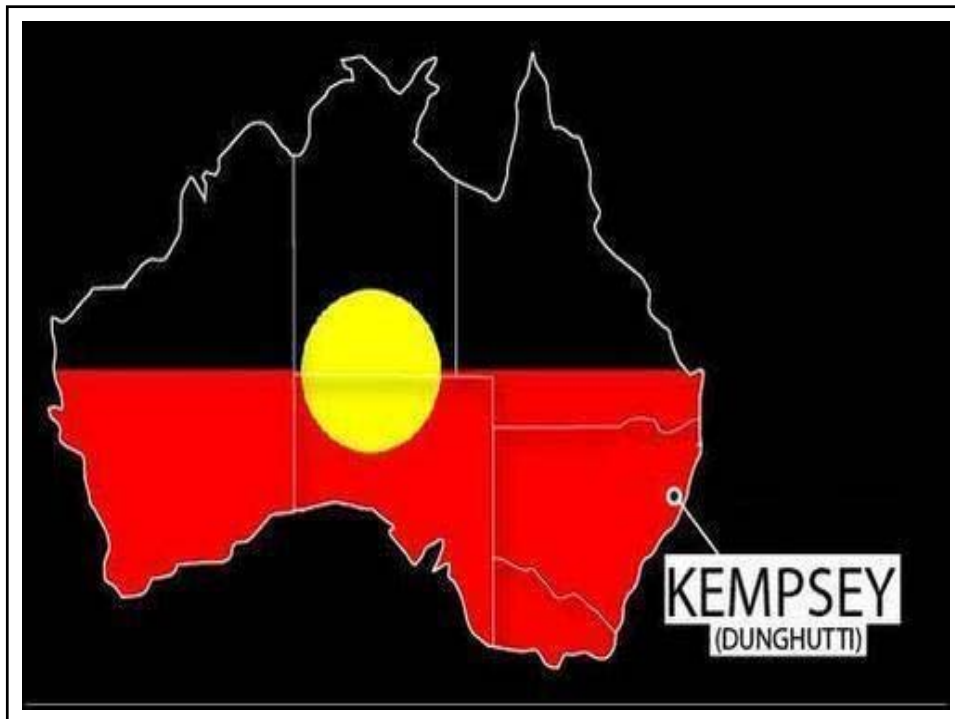

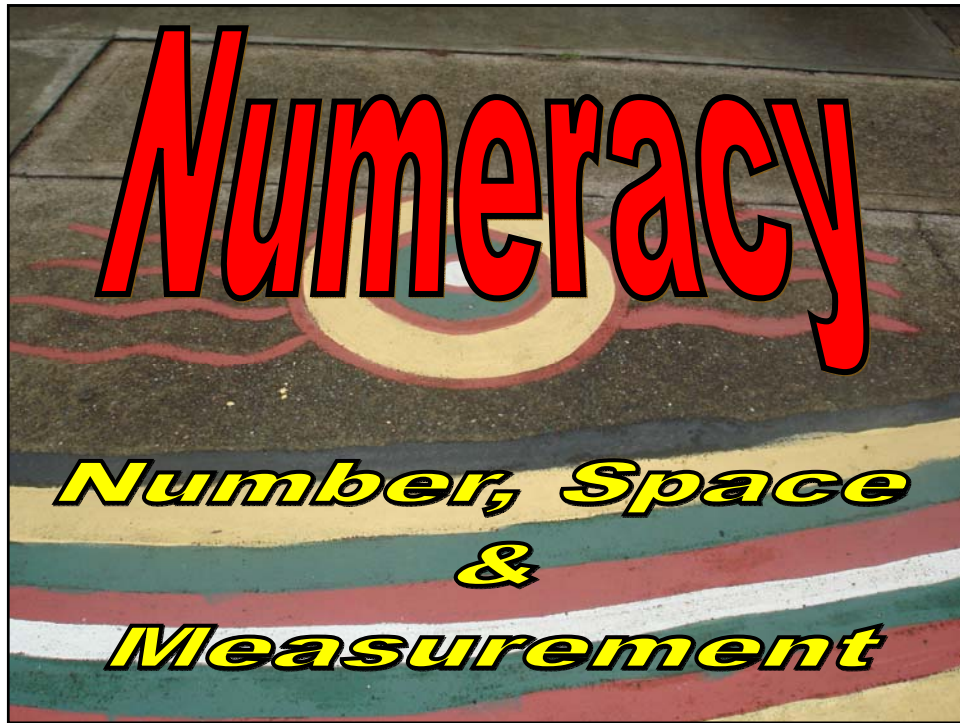


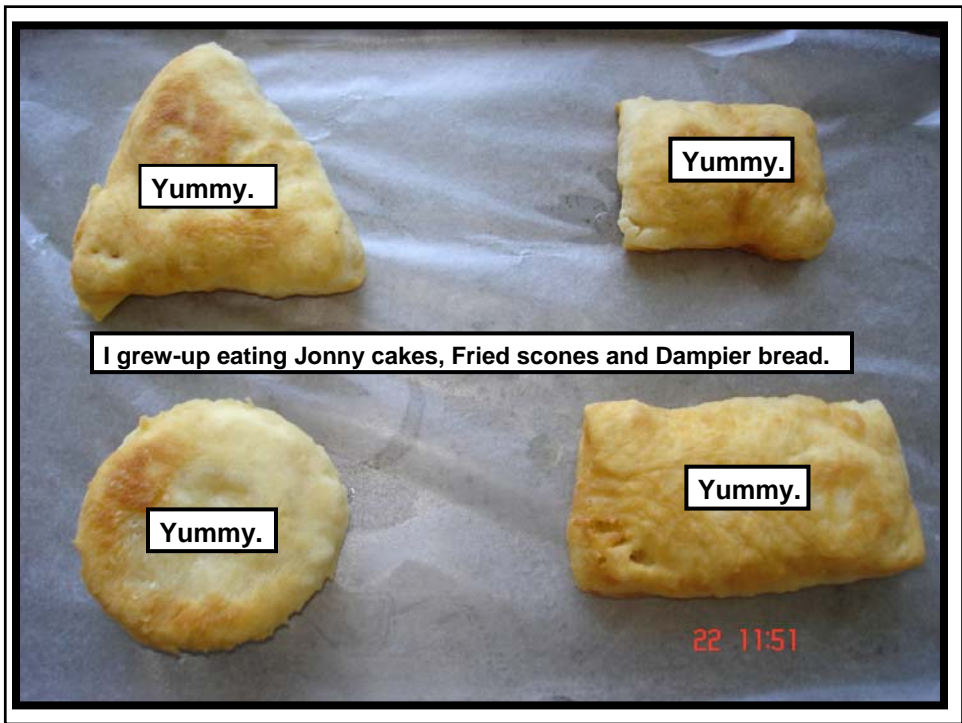
